



Uniform Policy

Rationale:

At St. Peter Julian Eymard School, students are expected to wear the correct school uniform as we believe it reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing our school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of our uniform.

Aims:

The wearing of uniforms at St. Peter Julian Eymard School aims:

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

Implementation:

- After consultation with the school community, the School Advisory Council has developed a Dress Code that we believe allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities, and caters for the financial constraints of families.
- Our school uniform applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms are prescribed, and are therefore required to be worn by all students. (Please refer to attachment for further details)
- Uniform infringement notices will be sent home to all students out of uniform.
- The school operates a uniform shop (staffed by volunteer parents), which is open twice per week.

Evaluation:

This uniform policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three-year review cycle. This process will be overseen by the Principal and Deputy Principal in conjunction with the whole staff and School Advisory Council.

Attachment 1- Outline of School Uniform

Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

Girls

- School dresses available ready made or material and pattern.
- Navy V necked monogrammed windcheater
- Navy knee high or ankle socks (not sockettes) and black school shoes / boots / plain black sandals (no heels and no decorations)

Boys

- SPJE monogrammed polo shirt
- Grey long line shorts
or
Grey zip front trousers (reinforced knee, standard school fabrics, not cargo pants)
- Navy V necked monogrammed windcheater
- Grey socks and black school shoes / boots

Winter Uniform (Terms 2 & 3)

Girls

- Winter tunic -available ready made or material and pattern
- Navy V necked monogrammed windcheater
- SPJE long sleeved polo shirt
- Navy Socks or tights
- Grey zip front trousers (reinforced knee, standard school fabrics, not cargo pants)

Boys

- Navy V necked monogrammed windcheater
- SPJE long sleeved polo shirt
- Grey zip front trousers – (reinforced knee, standard school fabrics, not cargo pants)

or
Grey long line shorts or trousers (as per Winter Uniform)

Sports

Girls

- SPJE blue polo shirt

- Burgundy sports skirt
or
- Navy blue rugby shorts
- Navy or white socks
- Navy tracksuit (Not fashion sports pants or with stripes, decorations, etc- Style as per uniform shop)

Boys

- SPJE blue polo shirt
- Navy blue rugby shorts
- Grey or white socks
- Navy tracksuit (Not fashion sports pants or with stripes, decorations, etc- Style as per uniform shop)

Hats

Blue school wide-brimmed or legionnaire style hats are compulsory at all levels for Term 1 & Term 4. During terms 2 and 3 students are permitted to wear official school navy beanies. These beanies may be purchased through the uniform shop.

Bags

SPJE school bags are part of our school uniform. These bags are available through the uniform shop, fashion bags are not acceptable.

Jewellery, Make-Up and Hair Decoration

- The only jewellery that should be worn is stud or sleeper earrings, a discreet chain (i.e. not able to be seen under school uniform) and a watch.
- Make-up is not acceptable.
- Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back.
- Hair decorations should be for practical purposes only. Excessive hair clips are unnecessary.
- Hair ribbons should be in school colours. NB. Scrunchies in school material available.
- Hair colouring is only acceptable in natural colour tonings.

Lost Property

Lost Property is located in the hall cupboard outside Prep F. Parents are encouraged to label all clothing and hats so that each item can be clearly identified. Parents wishing to sort through unclaimed jumpers, socks, shorts etc. can check through Lost Property during school hours.
